To simulate a job interview using ChatGPT, follow these steps:

1 Start by sharing job application

Begin the session by stating:

"I'm going to provide you with a job specification for a role I'm hoping to interview for. I would like you to act as the interviewer or recruiter and conduct a realistic interview with me. Do you understand?"

ChatGPT will acknowledge and confirm that it will take on the role of the interviewer and begin the interview accordingly.



2 Set your preferred interview style

Before the interview begins, clarify how you'd like the session to be structured. You can choose from two main formats:

- **One question at a time:** ChatGPT will ask a single interview question, wait for your response, and then provide feedback on your answer, including strengths and areas for improvement.
- **Full interview first, then feedback:** ChatGPT will conduct the entire interview without interruption. Once the interview is complete, it will then provide a comprehensive review of your performance.

Tip: Be clear about your preferred format when starting the interview so ChatGPT can follow the approach that works best for you.

3 Use voice input (optional)

For a more natural experience, you can use your voice to respond to questions. Simply click the microphone icon and allow access to your microphone when prompted. This can help you practice speaking confidently and clearly, just like in a real interview.

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Using your mobile phone

- **Download the App:** Go to the Google Play Store or Apple App Store and download the official ChatGPT app by OpenAI (ensure it's the genuine, free version).
- **Create or Log In:** Sign up for a free ChatGPT account, or log in if you already have one.
- **Start Practicing:** Use the voice conversation feature and tell ChatGPT that you'd like to practice your interview technique. You can then have a realistic, spoken mock interview session.
